Let someone know you're using a rideshare.
Tell them when you are leaving and
when you're expected to reach your destination.



Stay indoors or in a safe place when
scheduling a rideshare.



Travel with another person, if possible.



Check the driver's ratings.
After your ride, it helps others if you
can give feedback on your own ride.



When your ride arrives, verify that
the car and driver are correct.



If something doesn't feel right DO NOT get in the car.

Wear your seatbelt.



Do not reveal your personal information.



Use the app to track your ride.
